Important Things to Know Before Taking Lessons

- Turn in/mail the application to the church offices and an instructor will contact you to arrange lesson times.
- Students may be required to purchase materials to practice with. Some of these things may include a guitar, a tuner, a practice pad, drum sticks, a pitch pipe, sheet music, CDs, etc. depending on which lessons you are taking. Your instructor will inform you of what needs to be purchased when you start your lessons.
- Students are encouraged to practice at least 15 minutes everyday outside of lessons with hopes of getting about 2-3 hours of practice per week. Instructors will try their best to teach songs that you enjoy playing and singing to help you stay motivated to practice.
- One of our goals is to enable the students to be able to perform with other musicians. Occasionally students will perform their songs with other Music Academy students or other experienced musicians during our Academy Workshops.
- Lessons and Workshops will be held at the Bayside church offices at 2101 Freeway Dr. Suite A, Woodland, CA 95776.
- The cost is \$25 per lesson; the monthly total is due at the beginning of each month. There is no penalty for a rescheduled lesson, only a cancellation without proper notice.
- All checks are payable to Bayside Woodland.
- Instructors must be informed at least 24 hours in advance if you wish to cancel a lesson. If proper notification of a cancellation is not given you may forfeit a refund. Basically, if an instructor shows up to the lesson and the student pulls a “no-show”, the student will lose out, not the instructor.
