# Instructions to Set Up the Peril Game Board

## Print the "Answer Cards" Activity Pages on cardstock.

- This is the bottom layer of the game board.
- Arrange the pages so that the columns read "David, Abigail, Nabal" from left to right, and the points rows go from 100 to 600 in ascending order.
- Adhere the "Answer Board" Activity Page to a flat surface, such as a piece of poster board or foam core board.

## Print the "Question Cards" Activity Pages on cardstock.

- Cut the cards apart.
- Using the reference below, adhere each "Question Card" over the matching "Answer Card" with a piece of tape.
- You should be able to lift the "Question Card" to reveal the answer at the bottom without removing the card itself.

## Print the "Point Cards" Activity Pages.

- Cut the cards apart.
- Using the reference below, place each "Point Card" over the matching "Question Card."
- Use a small piece of tape to adhere the "Point Card" to the Answer Board surface.
- Avoid attaching this card directly to the question card, so that the point card can be removed without removing the question card.
