¹⁰ God's purpose in all this was to use the church to display his wisdom in its rich variety to all the unseen rulers and authorities in the heavenly places. Ephesians 3:10

¹⁴ So I bow in prayer before the Father ¹⁵ from whom every family in heaven and on earth gets its true name. Ephesians 3:14–15

¹⁶ I ask the Father in his great glory to give you the power to be strong inwardly through his Spirit. Ephesians 3:16

¹⁷ I pray that Christ will live in your hearts by faith and that your life will be strong in love and be built on love. Ephesians 3:17

¹⁸ And I pray that you and all God's holy people will have the power to understand the greatness of Christ's love—how wide and how long and how high and how deep that love is. Ephesians 3:18
